We MUST define the RSAs. We will identify where we are at, where we need to be, and how we were going to get there as far as completed technical reports goes. I want to list out every task that needs to be considered and or done, resource agencies we need to send requests for info to and exactly what were going to ask them.

Fred and Chock, pls be prepared with something visual for us to look at to facilitate discussion on this RSA subject..surface water and groundwater, edwards and trinity, and if there is anything else i am missing. On our 2/13 meeting Lena stated we were going to follow the CEQA guidance for cumulative effects, so unless yall have heard different, this is what we need to go by. See the RSA guidance in that documentation.

Fred, pls get the land use map for us to refer to.

Chock - did anyone ever get the "183" project information (veni's declaration cited it) for you? Ive never seen it.. Fred - if HNTB did this, can you provide for him?

One of the many things I am unclear on is the extent to which we need to study 1604 corridor now. It is on Brad's land use map. And in the context of cumulative impacts, 1604 is certainly a reasonably foreseeable project, if not tied to 281 via "toll starter" concept., plus I know mgmt wants to get FONSI on 1604 right after 281..so we really need to be working on both....However, I know Chock is not under contract for 1604 work. Fred, pls look into what has to be done for 281.

Lena - your on the list just as an FYI, but pls read paragraph above.

Vick - sorry we couldnt move this to later in the afternoon...with folks coming from houston, I dont want to take risk of cutting meeting off short.

Kemble - To my knowledge, you are not on the geology or water quality team, but you are doing karst survey work and your findings are directly applicable to these work groups. didnt think to ask you until just now. If you can make it, great.
